





1. Have I been pwnd?




Not directly a Web3 tool, but HaveIBeenPwnd allows you to check if your email has been compromised.

2. Web3 Antivirus




Web3 Antivirus is a security tool that helps you keep your crypto assets safe against scams and fraud

3. SafeSoul




Free browser extension integrated into Twitter alerts you to scams and suspicious activity in your feed. Immediate safety check for any open page: project on OS, scammed website etc.

4. Immunefi



Web3's leading bug bounty platform,
protecting \$60 billion in user funds

5. Harpie




Harpie is an on-chain firewall that protects users from hacks, scams, and theft.

6. Forta




Forta Network is a decentralized monitoring network designed to detect and address Web3 threats and anomalies in real-time using machine learning

7. Stelo




Stelo simulates every transaction before it reaches your wallet and explains what's happening in plain English

8. Wallet Guard

9. Fire




Fire is a free browser extension that simulates web3 transactions, showing you exactly what will enter and exit your wallet before you sign the contract.


11. L2beat
